## House Bill 2620

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires Department of Transportation, for purpose of identifying land that could be planned and zoned for residential use, to inventory department land, determine whether land is essential, useful or excessive in relation to transportation plans and report results to Legislative Assembly.

2	Relating to inventory of land owned by Department of Transportation.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "lot," "parcel" and "tract" have the meaning
5	given those terms in ORS 215.010.
6	(2) The Legislative Assembly finds and declares a need to identify land that can be
7	planned and zoned for residential use.
8	(3) The Department of Transportation shall conduct an inventory of the real property
9	owned by the department and make findings as to whether each lot, parcel or tract of land
10	is essential, useful or excessive in relation to the department's transportation plans for the
11	next years.
12	(4) The department shall report the inventory to the Legislative Assembly in the manne
13	described in ORS 192.245 on or before October 1, 2016.
