SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates offense of unlawful parking in space reserved for alternative fuel vehicle refueling. Punishes by maximum fine of \$250.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to parking offenses.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "alternative fuel vehicle" has the meaning given

5 that term in ORS 469B.100, except that "alternative fuel vehicle" includes vehicles registered

6 in any jurisdiction.

7 (2) A person commits the offense of unlawful parking in a space reserved for alternative 8 fuel vehicle refueling if:

9 (a) The person parks a vehicle in any parking space that is on premises open to the 10 public;

(b) The parking space is marked or signed as reserved for alternative fuel vehicle refu-eling; and

13 (c) The vehicle in the parking space is not engaged in the refueling process.

(3) The offense of unlawful parking in a space reserved for alternative fuel vehicle refu eling is a Class D traffic violation.
