

House Bill 2625

Sponsored by Representative REARDON; Representatives BARNHART, BOONE, CLEM, HELM, NATHANSON, TAYLOR (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates offense of unlawful parking in space reserved for alternative fuel vehicle refueling. Punishes by maximum fine of \$250.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to parking offenses.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "alternative fuel vehicle" has the meaning given**
5 **that term in ORS 469B.100, except that "alternative fuel vehicle" includes vehicles registered**
6 **in any jurisdiction.**

7 **(2) A person commits the offense of unlawful parking in a space reserved for alternative**
8 **fuel vehicle refueling if:**

9 **(a) The person parks a vehicle in any parking space that is on premises open to the**
10 **public;**

11 **(b) The parking space is marked or signed as reserved for alternative fuel vehicle refu-**
12 **eling; and**

13 **(c) The vehicle in the parking space is not engaged in the refueling process.**

14 **(3) The offense of unlawful parking in a space reserved for alternative fuel vehicle refu-**
15 **eling is a Class D traffic violation.**
