

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2642

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

June 30

1 On page 4 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 8 through 11 and insert:

2 “(c) Requiring a certified advanced esthetician to enter into an agreement with:

3 “(A) A physician licensed under ORS chapter 677 or a nurse practitioner licensed under ORS  
4 678.375 to 678.390; or

5 “(B) A licensed health care professional who works at the same location as the certified ad-  
6 vanced esthetician and who has the authority to prescribe drugs listed in Schedule III, IV or V.

7 “(3) The purpose of an agreement described in subsection (2)(c) of this section is to provide a  
8 certified advanced esthetician with a licensed health care professional to whom the certified ad-  
9 vanced esthetician may refer a client of the certified advanced esthetician.”.

10 On page 6, after line 1, insert:

11 “**SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
12 expenditures established by section 2, chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate  
13 Bill 5526), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-  
14 penses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, tobacco tax  
15 receipts, provider taxes, Medicare receipts and federal funds for indirect cost recovery,  
16 Supplemental Security Income recoveries, Women, Infants and Children Program food re-  
17 bates, the Coordinated School Health Program, the Edward Byrne Memorial State and Local  
18 Law Enforcement Assistance Grant Program, homeland security and emergency  
19 preparedness and response services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not de-  
20 scribed in section 2, chapter \_\_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), collected  
21 or received by the Oregon Health Authority, is increased by \$386,294 for the purpose of car-  
22 rying out the provisions of this 2015 Act.

23 “**SECTION 13.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
24 \$118,249 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for  
25 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,  
26 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Higher Education  
27 Coordinating Commission, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this 2015 Act.”.

28 In line 2, delete “12” and insert “14”.

29 In line 9, delete “13” and insert “15”.
