Requires financial institutions to permit individual convicted of crime to access banking and financial services.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to access to financial services for individual convicted of crime.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of the Bank Act.

5 SECTION 2. In a manner consistent with federal law, a financial institution shall permit

6 an individual who is otherwise qualified and who has been convicted of a crime in a court

7 of competent jurisdiction to:

8 (1) Open a deposit account or savings account;

9 (2) Initiate an electronic funds transfer from a deposit account or savings account in the

- 10 individual's name; and
- 11 (3) Initiate a rollover from the individual's individual retirement account.
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
