House Bill 2677

Sponsored by Representative KOMP (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Establishes standards for formative, interim-growth assessments to be used by school districts. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to formative interim-growth assessments; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 329.
 - SECTION 2. (1) Each school district shall use formative, interim-growth assessments as provided by this section. Formative, interim-growth assessments shall be selected by school districts from a list compiled by the Department of Education.
 - (2) Formative, interim-growth assessments shall be used for the purpose of supporting student learning by providing teachers with information to:
 - (a) Identify the necessary instructional modifications or interventions needed for students; and
 - (b) Tailor instruction to meet the learning needs of individual students.
 - (3) Formative, interim-growth assessments shall:
 - (a) Accurately measure student academic growth;
 - (b) Be based on national growth norms that allow for comparisons between students, groups of students, schools and school districts;
 - (c) Be based on a stable scale that has been validated over time;
 - (d) Measure students at, above and below grade levels to allow for the identification of the appropriate instructional modifications or interventions that will help all students learn; and
 - (e) Ensure fairness through empirical bias and sensitivity reviews.
 - (4) Formative, interim-growth assessments shall be administered:
 - (a) At the beginning of the school year, in the middle of the school year and the end of the school year; or
 - (b) At regular intervals determined by each school district.
 - (5) The results of formative, interim-growth assessments shall be provided in a timely manner and in a format that is useful to teachers, parents, administrators and students.
 - SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act applies to formative, interim-growth assessments administered on or after July 1, 2015.
 - SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
