

House Bill 2681

Sponsored by Representative KOMP (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs community colleges to use results from one of four nationally available standardized assessments for purpose of determining course placement of students at community college.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to course placement in community colleges; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 341.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) For the purpose of determining the placement of students in courses of-**
6 **fered by a community college, the board of education of a community college district shall**
7 **use the results from one of four nationally available standardized assessments.**

8 **(2) The standardized assessments that are acceptable under subsection (1) of this section**
9 **must:**

10 **(a) Be agreed upon by the boards of education of all of the community college districts**
11 **in this state;**

12 **(b) Include an assessment that is a suite of computerized tests used to determine a**
13 **student's knowledge in math, reading and writing for the purpose of placing the student in**
14 **appropriate post-secondary education courses; and**

15 **(c) Include a computer-adaptive assessment that is used to evaluate a student's skill level**
16 **in math, reading and writing for the purpose of placing the student in appropriate post-**
17 **secondary education courses.**

18 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2016.**

19 **SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
20 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
21 **on its passage.**
