Provides exception to offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a vehicle for persons operating farm vehicle.

 A BILL FOR AN ACT

 2 Relating to exceptions to the offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a vehicle; creating

3 new provisions; and amending ORS 811.200.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 811.200 is amended to read:

6 811.200. (1) A person commits the offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a vehicle if

7 the person carries a dog upon the hood, fender, running board or other external part of any auto-

8 mobile or truck that is upon a highway unless the dog is protected by framework, carrier or other 9 device sufficient to keep it from falling from the vehicle.

(2) A person does not commit the offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a
vehicle if, at the time the conduct occurs, the person is operating a farm vehicle registered
under ORS 805.300.

[(2)] (3) The offense described in this section, carrying dog on external part of vehicle, is a Class
 D traffic violation.

15 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 811.200 by section 1 of this 2015 Act apply to of-16 fenses occurring on or after the effective date of this 2015 Act.
