

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2687

1 Delete lines 5 through 15 of the printed A-engrossed bill and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 811.200 is amended to read:

3 “811.200. (1) A person commits the offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a vehicle
4 if the person carries a dog upon the hood, fender, running board, **truck bed** or other external part
5 of any automobile or truck that is upon a highway unless the dog is [*protected by framework, carrier*
6 *or other device sufficient to keep it from falling from the vehicle.*] **in an enclosed space or, if the**
7 **space is not enclosed, the dog is otherwise protected in a manner that will prevent the dog**
8 **from being thrown, falling or jumping from the vehicle, including but not limited to the fol-**
9 **lowing:**

10 “(a) **Securing the dog in a truck bed with walls that are at least 46 inches in height;**

11 “(b) **Cross tethering the dog to the vehicle; or**

12 “(c) **Placing the dog in a container or cage that is secured to the vehicle.**

13 “(2) **A person does not commit the offense of carrying a dog on the external part of a**
14 **vehicle if, at the time the conduct occurs, the person is:**

15 “(a) **Operating a farm vehicle registered under ORS 805.300; or**

16 “(b) **Engaged in commercial agriculture.**

17 “[2] (3) The offense described in this section, carrying a dog on **the** external part of **a** vehicle,
18 is a Class D traffic violation.”.
