SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Directs [Department of Education to conduct evaluation of use of standardized tests] Secretary of State to conduct audit of use of statewide summative assessment in public schools in this state.

Requires [department] Secretary of State to submit report to interim legislative committees no later than September 15, 2016.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to standardized tests; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) The Secretary of State shall conduct an audit related to the use in the public schools of this state of a statewide summative assessment developed by a multistate consortium. The audit must address the fiscal, administrative and educational impacts of the assessments on the public schools of this state, including the impacts on instructional time, curricula, the ability of educators to exercise professional judgment, budgets and administrative time and focus.

(2) The Secretary of State shall submit a report on the audit described in subsection (1) of this section to the interim legislative committees on education no later than September 15, 2016.

SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.
