**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Prohibits school district employee or volunteer from posting, publishing or making publicly available personally identifiable information in relation to results of performance-based assessment. **Allows exception if consent is given.**

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to assessment results; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 329.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided by subsection (2) of this section, a school district**  
6 **employee or volunteer may not post, publish or otherwise make publicly available in a non-**  
7 **secure setting any personally identifiable information in relation to the specific or compar-**  
8 **ative results of a performance-based assessment.**

9 **(2) A school district employee or volunteer may post, publish or otherwise make publicly**  
10 **available in a nonsecure setting the information described in subsection (1) of this section**  
11 **if the student who took the assessment, or the parent or guardian of the student who took**  
12 **the assessment, gives consent to post, publish or otherwise make publicly available the in-**  
13 **formation.**

14 **SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**  
16 **July 1, 2015.**
