

House Bill 2715

Sponsored by Representative FREDERICK (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits school district employee or volunteer from posting, publishing or making publicly available personally identifiable information in relation to results of performance-based assessment.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to assessment results; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 329.**

5 **SECTION 2. A school district employee or volunteer may not post, publish or otherwise**
6 **make publicly available in a nonsecure setting any personally identifiable information in re-**
7 **lation to the results of a performance-based assessment.**

8 **SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
10 **July 1, 2015.**
