House Bill 2724

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Authorizes agency to adopt criteria to waive application of rule, in whole or in part, in specified circumstance. Provides that criteria may not contravene legislative intent or purpose of enabling legislation.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to an agency's criteria for waiver of the application of a rule. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 183. 4

SECTION 2. (1) An agency may adopt by rule criteria and procedures to waive, on a $\mathbf{5}$

case-by-case basis, the application of a rule, in whole or in part, to a particular person in 6 7

specified circumstances except as expressly prohibited by law.

(2) The criteria adopted by an agency under subsection (1) of this section may not 8 contravene the legislative intent or overall purpose of the enabling legislation that author-9 10 ized the agency's adoption of the rule.
