

House Bill 2789

Sponsored by Representative PARRISH (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires all information provided as part of candidate's statement for voters' pamphlet to be true.

Punishes violation by maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to voters' pamphlet statements; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 251.085.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 251.085 is amended to read:

5 251.085. (1) The candidate's statement shall begin with a summary of the following: Occupation,
6 educational and occupational background, and prior governmental experience.

7 (2) **All information provided as part of the candidate's statement must be true. Knowingly**
8 **providing false information within the candidate's statement is a violation of ORS 260.715 (1).**

9 **SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 251.085 by section 1 of this 2015 Act first apply to**
10 **candidate statements submitted on or after the effective date of this 2015 Act.**
