## House Bill 2795

Sponsored by Representative PARRISH (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Modifies definitions of Class I, Class II and Class IV all-terrain vehicles.

- A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to all-terrain vehicles; amending ORS 801.190, 801.193 and 801.194.  $^{2}$ 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. ORS 801.190 is amended to read: 4 801.190. "Class I all-terrain vehicle" means a motorized, off-highway recreational vehicle that: 5 (1) Is 50 inches or less in width, as measured between the centerline of both rear tires; 6 7 (2) Has a dry weight of 1,200 pounds or less; 8 (3) Travels on three or more pneumatic tires that are six inches or more in width and that are 9 designed for use on wheels with a rim diameter of 14 inches or less; and 10 [(4) Uses handlebars for steering;] 11 [(5) Has a seat designed to be straddled for the operator; and] 12 [(6)] (4) Is designed for or capable of cross-country travel on or immediately over land, water, sand, snow, ice, marsh, swampland or other natural terrain. 13 SECTION 2. ORS 801.193 is amended to read: 14 15 801.193. "Class II all-terrain vehicle" means any motor vehicle that: [(1) Weighs more than or is wider than a Class I all-terrain vehicle;] 16 17 [(2) Is designed for or capable of cross-country travel on or immediately over land, water, sand, 18 snow, ice, marsh, swampland or other natural terrain;] (1) Is more than 50 inches in width, as measured between the centerline of both rear 19 20 tires; (2) Has a dry weight of 1,800 pounds or more; 21 (3) Is actually being operated off a highway or is being operated on a highway for agricultural 22 purposes under ORS 821.191; [and] 23 (4) Is not a Class IV all-terrain vehicle[.]; and 24
  - (2) "Class IV all-terrain vehicle" means any motorized vehicle that:
