

# House Bill 2810

Sponsored by Representative PARRISH

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Exempts certain electric vehicles from requirement to have two registration plates.  
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to vehicle registration plates; creating new provisions; amending ORS 803.525; and declar-  
3 ing an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 803.525 is amended to read:

6 803.525. The Department of Transportation shall issue two registration plates for every vehicle  
7 that is registered by the department except as otherwise provided in this section. Upon renewal or  
8 when otherwise provided under ORS 803.555, the department may issue stickers in lieu of or in ad-  
9 dition to registration plates. The following shall be issued plates as described:

10 (1) Only one registration plate shall be issued for a moped, motorcycle, trailer, antique vehicle  
11 or vehicle of special interest registered by the department.

12 (2) Only one plate shall be issued for a camper that is registered. Stickers may be issued in lieu  
13 of a plate.

14 (3) **Only one registration plate shall be issued for an electric vehicle registered by the**  
15 **department, if the manufacturer of the electric vehicle did not install a bracket to display a**  
16 **registration plate on the front of the vehicle.**

17 **SECTION 2.** The amendments to ORS 803.525 by section 1 of this 2015 Act apply to elec-  
18 tric vehicles registered on or after the effective date of this 2015 Act.

19 **SECTION 3.** This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
20 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect  
21 on its passage.
