

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2818

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 11, insert:

2 **“SECTION 3. (1) The Task Force on Charitable Checkoffs is established, consisting of five**
3 **members appointed as follows:**

4 **“(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint two members from among members of the**
5 **Senate.**

6 **“(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint three members from**
7 **among members of the House of Representatives.**

8 **“(2) The task force shall investigate the functioning of the charitable checkoff system**
9 **and what steps may be taken to improve functioning of the charitable checkoff system.**

10 **“(3) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the trans-**
11 **action of business.**

12 **“(4) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the members**
13 **of the task force.**

14 **“(5) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.**

15 **“(6) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appoint-**
16 **ment to become immediately effective.**

17 **“(7) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson**
18 **or of a majority of the members of the task force.**

19 **“(8) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**

20 **“(9) The Oregon Charitable Checkoff Commission shall provide staff support to the task**
21 **force.**

22 **“(10) The task force may presession file legislation in the manner provided in ORS 171.130**
23 **for interim committees. All legislation recommended by official action of the task force must**
24 **indicate that it is introduced at the request of the task force.**

25 **“(11) The task force shall report to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided in**
26 **ORS 192.245 at any time within 30 days after its final meeting or at such later time as the**
27 **President and Speaker may designate.**

28 **“(12) The Legislative Administrator may employ persons necessary for the performance**
29 **of the functions of the task force. The Legislative Administrator shall fix the duties and**
30 **amounts of compensation of these employees. The task force shall use the services of con-**
31 **tinuing legislative staff, without employing additional persons, to the greatest extent practi-**
32 **cable.**

33 **“(13) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist**
34 **the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating**
35 **to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force**

1 **consider necessary to perform their duties.**

2 **SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2015 Act is repealed on December 31, 2015.”.**

3 In line 12, delete “3” and insert “5”.

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
