House Bill 2827

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Department of Transportation to study addition of express lanes to certain highways in this state.

Sunsets January 2, 2018.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT 2 Relating to transportation. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall conduct a study regarding the addition of express lanes to the highways listed in subsection (2) of this section and make a 5 report of its findings. 6 7 (2) The department shall study the addition of express lanes to all of the following high-8 ways: (a) U.S. Highway 26 between Portland and Hillsboro. 9 10 (b) Oregon Route 217 between Interstate 5 and U.S. Highway 26. (c) Interstate 5 between Oregon Route 217 and Interstate 405. 11 12 (3) The report must include: (a) Information about how the addition of express lanes to the highways listed in sub-13 section (2) of this section would affect the flow of traffic; 14 (b) Information about the feasibility of adding express lanes to the highways listed in 15 subsection (2) of this section; and 16 (c) Recommendations, if any, for necessary legislative actions needed to add express 17 lanes to the highways listed in subsection (2) of this section. 18 19 (4) The department shall report its findings to an interim committee of the Legislative 20 Assembly related to transportation no later than September 15, 2017.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on January 2, 2018.
