SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Extends, for two years, sunset of provisions requiring Oregon Health Authority to study and make recommendations to Legislative Assembly on best option for financing health care in this state.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to a study on financing health care in this state; creating new provisions; and amending 2 sections 3 and 4, chapter 712, Oregon Laws 2013. 3

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

SECTION 1. Section 4, chapter 712, Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to read: 5

Sec. 4. Sections 1 and 2, [of this 2013 Act] chapter 712, Oregon Laws 2013, are repealed on 6 7 January 2, [2016] 2018.

SECTION 2. Section 3, chapter 712, Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to read:

Sec. 3. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall report on the progress of the study described in 9

10 section 1, [of this 2013 Act] chapter 712, Oregon Laws 2013, to the [2014] 2016 regular session of the Legislative Assembly. 11

12 (2) No later than November 1, [2014] 2016, the authority shall submit the report described in 13 section 1, [of this 2013 Act] chapter 712, Oregon Laws 2013, to the interim committees on health care in the House of Representatives and the Senate. 14

(3) The authority shall submit the report to the [2015] 2017 regular session of the Legislative 15 Assembly in the manner prescribed by ORS 192.245. 16

SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-17ated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the 18 General Fund, the amount of \$_____, which may be expended for carrying out sections 1 19 20 and 2, chapter 712, Oregon Laws 2013.
