## House Bill 2837

Sponsored by Representative GOMBERG

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Director of Transportation to issue certificate of exemption from requirement to use child safety system, safety belt or safety harness if statement is submitted by nurse practitioner or physician assistant on behalf of person requesting exemption.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to certificates of exemption issued by the Director of Transportation; amending ORS 2 811.220.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

SECTION 1. ORS 811.220 is amended to read:  $\mathbf{5}$ 

811.220. The Director of Transportation shall issue a certificate of exemption required under 6

7 ORS 811.215 for any person on whose behalf a statement signed by a physician, nurse practitioner

8 or physician assistant is presented to the Department of Transportation. For a physician's, nurse

practitioner's or physician assistant's statement to qualify under this section, the physician, 9

nurse practitioner or physician assistant giving the statement must set forth reasons in the 10

statement why use of a child safety system, safety belt or safety harness by the person would be 11

impractical or harmful to the person by reason of physical condition, medical problem or body size. 12

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
