House Bill 2875

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH CARE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services to conduct study on effectiveness of laws establishing processes and procedures for pharmacy benefit managers. Requires department to make report of findings and submit report to interim committee related to health care no later than September 15, 2015.

Sunsets on date of convening of 2016 regular session of Legislative Assembly. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to pharmacy benefit managers; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall conduct a study on the effectiveness of ORS 735.530 to 735.552. As part of the study, the department 5 shall examine whether the appeals process described in ORS 735.534 and the claims auditing 6 procedures described in ORS 735.540 to 735.552 require additional regulatory oversight, in-7 8 cluding whether the department or another state agency should conduct investigations pur-9 suant to complaints that the provisions are being violated. If the department determines that such investigations are necessary, the department also shall determine the type of discipline 10 that is most likely to deter future violations. 11 12 (2) The department shall make a report of the department's findings under subsection (1) of this section. The department shall submit the report in the manner provided by ORS 13 192.245 to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to health care no later 14

15 than September 15, 2015.

16 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the 2016 17 regular session of the Legislative Assembly as specified in ORS 171.010.

18 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 19 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 20 on its passage.
