House Bill 2885

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Provides that Oregon Liquor Control Commission may delay issuing licenses to applicants for processing marijuana products that are intended to be consumed as food or as potable liquid until July 1, 2016. Sunsets January 2, 2017.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of sections 3 to 70,
5	chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015.
6	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding section 18 (1), chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, the Oregon
7	Liquor Control Commission:
8	(1) Is not required to issue licenses to applicants for a processor license under section
9	20, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2015, until July 1, 2016, if the marijuana products to be processed
10	at the proposed premises are intended to be consumed as a food product or as potable liquid.
11	(2) May condition the issuance of any license issued under section 20, chapter 1, Oregon
12	Laws 2015, on the holder of the license not processing marijuana products that are intended
13	to be consumed as a food product or potable liquid until July 1, 2016.

SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is repealed on January 2, 2017.
