House Bill 2917

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON CONSUMER PROTECTION AND GOVERNMENT EFFECTIVENESS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services to study impacts of paycheck discounting and report to Legislative Assembly on or before September 15, 2015.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to paycheck discounting; and declaring an emergency. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall study the impacts of paycheck discounting by financial institutions operating in this state. The department 5 shall report its findings, in the manner specified in ORS 192.245, to the Legislative Assembly 6 7 not later than September 15, 2015. SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 8 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 9 10 on its passage. 11
