

House Bill 2933

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH CARE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes Oregon Medical Board to impose civil penalties on persons not licensed by board.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to civil penalties imposed by the Oregon Medical Board; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 677.**

5 **SECTION 2. In addition to any other liability or penalty provided by law, the Oregon**
6 **Medical Board may impose for each violation of a provision of this chapter or for each vio-**
7 **lation of a rule adopted under a provision of this chapter a civil penalty that does not exceed**
8 **\$10,000. The board shall impose civil penalties under this section in the manner provided by**
9 **ORS 183.745.**

10 **SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.**
