SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Prohibits city from requiring consent to annexation of landowner's property in exchange for city providing county service as agent of county.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to annexation; amending ORS 222.115; and declaring an emergency. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. ORS 222.115 is amended to read: 222.115. (1) A contract between a city and a landowner containing the landowner's consent to 5 eventual annexation of the landowner's property in return for extraterritorial services: 6 7 [(1)] (a) Must be recorded; and 8 [(2)] (b) When recorded, is binding on successors in interest in that property. (2) A city may not require consent to annexation of a landowner's property in exchange 9 10 for the city providing a county service as an agent of the county. SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 11 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 12 on its passage. 13 14
