House Bill 2951

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH CARE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires policies and certificates of health insurance that offer prescription drug coverage to meet specified cost-sharing requirements.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to insurance coverage of prescription drugs.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of the Insurance Code.
5	SECTION 2. A policy or certificate of health insurance offered in this state that provides
6	payment or reimbursement for the cost of prescription drugs is subject to all of the following
7	requirements:
8	(1) The combined cost of copayments and coinsurance for a 30-day supply of a pre-
9	scription drug may not exceed \$100.
10	(2) Prescription drugs may not be subject to a deductible.
11	(3) The cost of copayments and coinsurance for covered prescription drugs must apply
12	to any deductible.
13	(4) All drugs within a therapeutic or pharmacological class may not be made subject to
14	the cost tier for which an enrollee incurs the highest out-of-pocket costs.
15	(5) There must be a process for an enrollee to obtain an exception to any coverage limi-
16	tation or cost-sharing that is based on a drug not being on a formulary or preferred drug list.
17	SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act applies to policies and certificates of insurance
18	issued, extended or renewed on or after the effective date of this 2015 Act.

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
