

House Bill 2964

Sponsored by Representative BARTON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Law Commission to submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than July 1, 2016, regarding recommendations for compiling data and information regarding protected persons in Oregon who are subject to guardianship or conservatorship proceedings.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to protected persons; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) No later than July 1, 2016, the Oregon Law Commission shall submit a**
5 **report to the interim legislative committees with subject matter jurisdiction of the judiciary,**
6 **in particular, of protective proceedings, for the purpose of making recommendations re-**
7 **garding compiling data and information about protected persons in Oregon who are the**
8 **subject of guardianship or conservatorship proceedings.**

9 (2) The report shall include but not be limited to the following:

10 (a) A summary of current methods of tracking persons in Oregon who are protected
11 persons subject to guardianships or conservatorships in this state;

12 (b) A summary of relevant statistics regarding the number, age, location, health and
13 medical conditions and financial statuses of persons who are protected persons in
14 guardianships and conservatorships in this state; and

15 (c) Recommendations for legislative changes to existing statutes that will implement a
16 means of tracking data and information about protected persons in guardianship and con-
17 servatorship proceedings in this state.

18 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
19 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
20 **on its passage.**
