House Bill 2966

Sponsored by Representative BARTON (at the request of Jonathan Schell, L.Ac.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Oregon Medical Board to study regulation of and reimbursement for acupuncture services and report to Legislative Assembly on or before September 15, 2015.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to acupuncture; and declaring an emergency. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. The Oregon Medical Board shall study the need for and impacts of increased regulation of and reimbursement for acupuncture services. The board shall report its 5 findings, in the manner specified in ORS 192.245, to the Legislative Assembly not later than 6 7 September 15, 2015. SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 8 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 9 10 on its passage.
