

House Bill 2974

Sponsored by Representatives LININGER, MCLAIN; Representative JOHNSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Legislative Assembly or Secretary of State to hold public hearings throughout state prior to adopting congressional or legislative reapportionment plan.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to reapportionment.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 188.010 to**
5 **188.295.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) When apportioning the state into congressional or legislative districts,**
7 **the Legislative Assembly or the Secretary of State, whichever is applicable, shall:**

8 **(a) Hold at least 10 public hearings at locations throughout the state prior to proposing**
9 **a reapportionment plan; and**

10 **(b) Hold at least five public hearings at locations throughout the state after a reappor-**
11 **tionment plan is proposed, but before the plan is adopted.**

12 **(2) In holding the hearings required under subsection (1) of this section, the Legislative**
13 **Assembly or the Secretary of State, whichever is applicable, must:**

14 **(a) Provide appropriate public notice of the time and location of each hearing;**

15 **(b) Hold at least one hearing required under subsection (1)(a) of this section and one**
16 **hearing required under subsection (1)(b) of this section in areas that have experienced the**
17 **largest shifts in population since the previous reapportionment, and prioritize holding addi-**
18 **tional public hearings in these areas; and**

19 **(c) Permit and make provision for individuals at remote sites throughout the state to**
20 **provide public testimony at the hearings through the use of video equipment.**
