HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2996

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 9, insert:

"(6) In order to ensure that the center is effectively performing its duties under this section, the center shall track key performance indicators and report annually on the status of these performance indicators to the Department of Consumer and Business Services. The performance indicators tracked by the center and reported to the department must include, but are not limited to:

6 "(a) The improvement in workforce development, as measured by the increased number of stu-7 dents enrolled in cyber-related programs annually;

8 "(b) The success of the center in identifying critical post-graduate or post-secondary cyber-9 credentials, as determined each biennium by:

"(A) The number of new and existing continuing education and workforce training hours offered;and

"(B) The number of workers trained by affiliate programs;

"(c) The annual amount of independent support funds raised for research and fees for services
in support of the center;

15 "(d) Community involvement and the number of independent businesses involved with educa-16 tional and response activity through the center on an annual basis;

"(e) The number of businesses that create business continuity plans or that use the center's cyber-security tools annually; and

"(f) The ability of the center to develop methods to track potential risk and the resulting amount of money saved by Oregon businesses annually.".

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
