

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2996

By COMMITTEE ON HIGHER EDUCATION, INNOVATION, AND WORKFORCE
DEVELOPMENT

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 9, insert:

2 “(6) In order to ensure that the center is effectively performing its duties under this section, the
3 center shall track key performance indicators and report annually on the status of these perform-
4 ance indicators to the Department of Consumer and Business Services. The performance indicators
5 tracked by the center and reported to the department must include, but are not limited to:

6 “(a) The improvement in workforce development, as measured by the increased number of stu-
7 dents enrolled in cyber-related programs annually;

8 “(b) The success of the center in identifying critical post-graduate or post-secondary cyber-
9 credentials, as determined each biennium by:

10 “(A) The number of new and existing continuing education and workforce training hours offered;
11 and

12 “(B) The number of workers trained by affiliate programs;

13 “(c) The annual amount of independent support funds raised for research and fees for services
14 in support of the center;

15 “(d) Community involvement and the number of independent businesses involved with educa-
16 tional and response activity through the center on an annual basis;

17 “(e) The number of businesses that create business continuity plans or that use the center’s
18 cyber-security tools annually; and

19 “(f) The ability of the center to develop methods to track potential risk and the resulting amount
20 of money saved by Oregon businesses annually.”.

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
