

House Bill 3005

Sponsored by Representative WILSON; Representatives BUEHLER, ESQUIVEL, KENNEMER, NEARMAN, POST, SPRENGER, STARK, WHISNANT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Extends expiration date of driver license for persons volunteering outside of United States. Provides that driver license expires 90 days after person returns to United States.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to persons volunteering outside of the United States.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle**
5 **Code.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 807.130, a driver license held by a person described**
7 **in subsection (2) of this section that expires while the holder is volunteering outside of the**
8 **United States shall remain valid and grant driving privileges for 90 days after the date the**
9 **person returns to the United States.**

10 **(2) Subsection (1) of this section applies to persons who are performing services in a lo-**
11 **cation outside of the United States on a volunteer basis for a nonprofit religious, charitable**
12 **or relief organization, whether or not such persons receive meals or lodging or reimburse-**
13 **ments or vouchers for meals, lodging or expenses.**

14 **(3) The court shall dismiss the charge of operating a vehicle without driving privileges**
15 **under ORS 807.010 if, when charged, a person described in subsection (2) of this section held**
16 **a valid driver license pursuant to subsection (1) of this section.**

17 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act applies to driver licenses that expire on or after**
18 **the effective date of this 2015 Act.**
