## **SUMMARY**

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to conduct study on mental health courts and present report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2016.

Sunsets January 2, 2017.

- 2 Relating to mental health courts.
  - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
    - SECTION 1. The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall conduct a study on the efficacy of mental health courts currently operating within this state. The commission shall present the results of the study, along with any recommendations for legislation, in a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before September 15, 2016.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on January 2, 2017.
