

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3041

1 Delete lines 5 through 21 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) Each school district shall allow the following during school hours, at a**
3 **school-sponsored activity or while under the supervision of school personnel:**

4 **“(a) The outdoor use by students of sun-protective clothing, including hats.**

5 **“(b) The application of and use by students of nonprescription sunscreen, including**
6 **sunscreen that contains para-aminobenzoic acid, without any required documentation from**
7 **a licensed health care professional.**

8 **“(2) Nothing in subsection (1)(a) of this section prevents a school district from prohibit-**
9 **ing certain clothing or hats based on the inappropriateness of the graphics, color or message**
10 **of the clothing or hats.**

11 **“(3) A school district may allow school personnel to assist students in applying**
12 **nonprescription sunscreen but may not require school personnel to assist students in apply-**
13 **ing nonprescription sunscreen.**

14 **“(4) School personnel may not be held liable in a criminal action or for civil damages for**
15 **application of nonprescription sunscreen, including sunscreen that contains para-**
16 **aminobenzoic acid, if the nonprescription sunscreen is available to and used by the student**
17 **in accordance with this section.”.**
