## **A-Engrossed** House Bill 3058

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure

Permits certain Public Employee Retirement System [member who is] members who are retired to be employed by school district or education service district as [teacher] teachers of career and technical education without loss of retirement benefits.

Sunsets June 30, 2018.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to pensions; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 238.

SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "teacher of career and technical education" 5

6 means a teacher licensed by the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to instruct 7 any career and technical education course or program in any career and technical education 8 field.

9 (2) The limitations on employment imposed by ORS 238.082 (2) and (3) do not apply to a 10 retired member who is employed by a school district or an education service district as a 11 teacher of career and technical education.

12 (3) This section applies to a person who retires under the provisions of ORS 238.280 (1),

13 (2) or (3) as long as the person's date of retirement is more than six months before the date 14 the person is employed under this section.

15(4) Employment under this section does not affect the status of a person as a retired 16 member of the Public Employees Retirement System and a recipient of retirement benefits 17 under this chapter.

18 (5) Hours worked by a person employed under subsection (2) of this section shall not be 19 counted for the purpose of the limitations on employment imposed by ORS 238.082 (2) and (3). 20

SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is repealed on June 30, 2018.

SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 2122peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 23on its passage.
