SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries to conduct study of mineral resource potential in Oregon and present report to Legislative Assembly by February 1 of each odd-numbered year.

2 Relating to study of mineral resource potential in Oregon.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries shall conduct**
5 **a study of the mineral resource potential of all geographic areas of the State of Oregon ex-**
6 **cept the Willamette Valley and present the results of the study in a report to the Legislative**
7 **Assembly in the manner provided in ORS 192.245 on or before February 1 of each odd-**
8 **numbered year.**

9 (2) The department shall post the report prepared pursuant to subsection (1) of this
10 section on the department's website.
