

House Bill 3136

Sponsored by Representative JOHNSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to collect information on curriculum for teacher education programs.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to requirements of educator candidates; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 342.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) The Teacher Standards and Practices Commission shall collect informa-**
6 **tion on the curriculum for teacher education programs, including the proficiencies that**
7 **candidates of the programs are required to meet and the instructional materials that are**
8 **used in the programs.**

9 **(2) The commission shall make available the information collected as provided by sub-**
10 **section (1) of this section on the website of the commission.**

11 **SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
13 **on its passage.**
