

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO B-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3243

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 5 of the printed B-engrossed bill, after line 14, insert:

2 “**SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
3 expenditures established by section 1, chapter 192, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill  
4 5023), as modified by legislative or Emergency Board action, for the biennium beginning July  
5 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,  
6 including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or  
7 received by the State Mortuary and Cemetery Board, is increased by \$378,000 for the pur-  
8 poses of administering the amendments to ORS 97.170, 97.180, 97.190, 97.200, 97.990, 413.825  
9 and 692.040 by sections 1 to 7 of this 2015 Act.

10 “**SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
11 expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate  
12 Bill 5526), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-  
13 penses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, tobacco tax  
14 receipts, provider taxes, Medicare receipts and federal funds for indirect cost recovery,  
15 Supplemental Security Income recoveries, Women, Infants and Children Program food re-  
16 bates, the Coordinated School Health Program, the Edward Byrne Memorial State and Local  
17 Law Enforcement Assistance Grant Program, homeland security and emergency  
18 preparedness and response services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not de-  
19 scribed in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5526), collected or  
20 received by the Oregon Health Authority, is decreased by \$378,000.”.

21 In line 15, delete “8” and insert “10”.

22 In line 22, delete “9” and insert “11”.
