SUMMARY

Creates offense of failure of bicycle operator to wear reflective clothing. Punishes by maximum fine of \$250.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to bicycles. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle 4 Code. 5 6 SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the offense of failure of a bicycle operator to wear 7 reflective clothing if the person operates a bicycle on a highway or on premises open to the 8 public and is not wearing reflective clothing, including but not limited to a reflective coat or reflective vest. (2) This section does not apply at any time between sunrise and sunset. 10 (3) The offense described in this section, failure of a bicycle operator to wear reflective 11 12 clothing, is a Class D traffic violation. 13
