SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Directs Oregon Business Development Department to conduct study and submit report to interim legislative committees, no later than December 31, 2016, regarding methods to expand [*technology*] **broadband and telecommunications** infrastructure in rural cities and counties in Oregon.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to expansion of technology infrastructure in rural Oregon; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) No later than December 31, 2016, the Oregon Business Development De-**
5 **partment shall conduct a study and submit a report to the interim legislative committees**
6 **on economic development regarding methods to expand broadband and telecommunications**
7 **infrastructure in rural cities and counties in Oregon.**

8 **(2) The report may include recommendations for legislative changes.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
