

House Bill 3294

Sponsored by Representatives SPRENGER, RAYFIELD; Representatives BENTZ, NEARMAN, OLSON, WHISNANT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Secretary of State to conduct analysis on most effective and cost-efficient method or methods for candidates to provide voters' pamphlet statements in special district elections.

Requires secretary to submit report to Legislative Assembly.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to voters' pamphlet statements in special district elections; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Secretary of State shall conduct an analysis and determine the most**
5 **effective and cost-efficient method or methods for candidates to provide voters' pamphlet**
6 **statements in special district elections.**

7 **(2) The secretary shall submit a report on the analysis described in subsection (1) of this**
8 **section to the interim legislative committees on rules no later than September 15, 2015.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
