SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Directs school districts to submit report to Department of Education [to evaluate methods] on strategies and activities used to reduce dropout rates.

[Declares emergency, effective on passage.]

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to dropout prevention.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1)(a) Each school district shall submit a report to the Department of Education that describes the strategies or activities used by the school district to reduce dropout rates, including strategies or activities to increase district high school graduation rates or reduce chronic absenteeism.
 - (b) School districts shall submit reports under this subsection:
 - (A) In the manner prescribed by the department; and
 - (B) No later than June 30 of each even-numbered year.
 - (2)(a) The department shall submit a report to the interim legislative committees on education that summarizes the strategies and activities described in the reports submitted under subsection (1) of this section.
 - (b) The department shall submit reports under this subsection no later than December 1 of each even-numbered year.
 - SECTION 2. (1) School districts shall first submit the reports required under section 1 (1) of this 2015 Act no later than June 30, 2016.
 - (2) The Department of Education shall first submit the report required under section 1 (2) of this 2015 Act no later than December 1, 2016.

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
