House Bill 3320

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Secretary of State to conduct analysis on most effective method or methods for increasing elector participation in elections.

Requires secretary to submit report to Legislative Assembly. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to voting; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Secretary of State shall conduct an analysis and determine the most
5	effective method or methods for increasing elector participation in elections.
6	(2) The secretary shall submit a report on the analysis described in subsection (1) of this
7	section to the interim legislative committees on rules no later than September 15, 2015.
8	SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
9	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
10	on its passage.
