House Bill 3334

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board to spend \$2 million per year out of Flexible Incentives Account on implementation of strategies to protect and restore sage grouse habitat. Sunsets on January 2, 2021.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to sage grouse habitat; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. For the period beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2020, the Oregon
- 5 Watershed Enhancement Board shall spend \$2 million per year out of the funds credited to
- 6 the Flexible Incentives Account established under ORS 541.937 on the implementation of
- 7 strategies intended to protect and restore sage grouse habitat.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on January 2, 2021.
- 9 SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
- 10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
- 11 **on July 1, 2015.**
