CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to university degree programs; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall work with public universities listed in ORS 352.002 to develop effective solutions to address the problem of students who:**

- (1) Enroll in a public university listed in ORS 352.002;**
- (2) Successfully complete two or more years of coursework at the university; and**
- (3) Leave the university without graduating and without any official recognition of their academic accomplishments.**

**SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on July 1, 2020.**

**SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.**
