SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Transfers Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to Department of Education. Transfers duties, functions and powers of commission to State Board of Education and Department of Education, except disciplinary procedures.]

[Changes name of Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to Teacher Standards and Practices Division.]

Directs Secretary of State to conduct audit related to Teacher Standards and Practices Commission.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Secretary of State shall conduct an audit related to the Teacher
5	Standards and Practices Commission.
6	(2) The audit required by this section must address:
7	(a) The finances of the commission;
8	(b) The business practices of the commission, including the commission's licensing and
9	educator oversight responsibilities; and
10	(c) The impact that the commission has on educators, teacher education institutions and
11	teacher education programs.
12	(3) The Secretary of State shall submit a report on the audit required by this section to
13	the interim legislative committees on education no later than September 15, 2015.
14	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on December 31, 2015.
15	SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
16	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
17	on its passage.

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
