

# House Bill 3356

Sponsored by Representative LIVELY; Representative SPRENGER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to administer program to provide loans to hospitals for establishing new primary care residency programs.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to the primary care physician shortage.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall administer a program to provide loans**  
5 **to hospitals for the purpose of establishing new primary care residency programs.**

6 **(2) The authority shall adopt rules establishing eligibility criteria for obtaining loans,**  
7 **application procedures, repayment requirements, interest or other charges and procedures**  
8 **in case of default. Loans must be repaid within a 10-year period.**

9 **(3) Loans shall be paid out of funds transferred to the authority from the Administrative**  
10 **Services Economic Development Fund in section 2 of this 2015 Act.**

11 **SECTION 2. There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, from the Admin-**  
12 **istrative Services Economic Development Fund, to the Oregon Health Authority, the amount**  
13 **of \$50 million for providing loans to the program described in section 1 of this 2015 Act.**  
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**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
