

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3391

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 12 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** (1) The Attorney General may bring an action in a circuit court for a citation
3 or a stalking protective order under ORS 30.866 or 163.730 to 163.750 on behalf of an employee of
4 the Department of Human Services who, because of being involved in the conduct described in
5 subsection (3) of this section, is the subject of repeated and unwanted contact by another person
6 that causes alarm or coercion to the employee. The Attorney General’s responsibility under this
7 subsection is limited to circumstances in which an employee of the department submits a written
8 request to the Attorney General that:

9 “(a) Has been approved in writing by the Director of Human Services or the director’s designee;

10 “(b) Sets forth sufficient facts and evidence, the truth of which has been affirmed by the em-
11 ployee; and

12 “(c) Based solely upon the opinion of the Attorney General, is an action that is likely to suc-
13 ceed.

14 “(2) The action brought under this section may not include a request for:

15 “(a) Special and general damages, including damages for emotional distress;

16 “(b) Economic or noneconomic damages;

17 “(c) Punitive damages; or

18 “(d) Attorney fees and costs.”.

19 In line 13, delete “(2)” and insert “(3)”.
