

# House Bill 3407

Sponsored by Representative GORSEK

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct survey of community college students related to students' child care needs.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to child care at community colleges; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall conduct a survey**  
5 **of community college students to identify the child care needs of the students and to deter-**  
6 **mine the best means of meeting the child care needs of the students to enable the students**  
7 **to attend community college.**

8 **(2) No later than September 15, 2015, the commission shall submit to the interim legis-**  
9 **lative committees on education:**

10 **(a) A report that summarizes the findings of the survey conducted under subsection (1)**  
11 **of this section; and**

12 **(b) Recommendations for legislation or funding to ensure that appropriate child care is**  
13 **available to students of the community colleges of this state.**

14 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**  
16 **on its passage.**
