## House Bill 3407

Sponsored by Representative GORSEK

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct survey of community college students related to students' child care needs. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to child care at community colleges; and declaring an emergency.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall conduct a survey
of community college students to identify the child care needs of the students and to determine the best means of meeting the child care needs of the students to enable the students
to attend community college.
(2) No later than September 15, 2015, the commission shall submit to the interim legislative committees on education:
(a) A report that summarizes the findings of the survey conducted under subsection (1)

11 of this section; and

(b) Recommendations for legislation or funding to ensure that appropriate child care is
 available to students of the community colleges of this state.

14 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 15 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 16 on its passage.
